





Changes to prices for accessing Scottish datasets

To be aware, from 1 April 2025 there is a new sustainable pricing model in place, resulting in a price increase

Costs cover the services we (RDS & partners) provide such as advice on data availability / linkage, technical infrastructure – **NOT** for the data itself

one-off step change in pricing structure to bring our system to a level where it is covering costs.

Component pricing introduced – only pay for what you need


